Door-to-door collection service

Separating to improve

In the year 2014, Artà successfully initiated the door-to-door waste collection service. This type of service requires an important individual and collective effort.

Despite this, the dedication and conviction of the inhabitants of Artà has made it possible to overcome any difficulty and we have become one of the municipalities that recycles the most in Mallorca.

Remember that all the waste you separate correctly serves as raw material which is used to make new products. On the other hand, non-recycled waste is incinerated creating pollution and unnecessary economic spending.

Separating waste at home requires an important level of understanding of the specific questions outlined in this leaflet. If in doubt, please contact the Town Council.

How to prepare the waste for collection



Paper

In a bucket, cardboard box, paper bag or bin bag.

Plastic containers



In a plastic bag.

Glass



In a bucket.

Orgànica



in a bucket with a compostable bin bag.

Other types of waste



In a plastic bag.

Nappies



in an independently bought white or transparent plastic bag.



This is the aerated bin which helps to eliminate odours.

Advice

There is no need to wash plastic containers or glass. **Don't waste water.**

Crush cardboard and light packaging to save on space at home and for the collection lorries.

The Green Recycling Park and the Artàcard

The Parc Verd (Green Recycling Park) accepts any household waste properly separated (paper and cardboard, plastic packaging, glass containers, organic and other types of waste).

To make use of this service you must present the free ArtàCard (request your card from the Town Council). You can also take special waste which is not collected through the door-to-door collection system to the Parc Verd.

Special Waste

- Bulky waste *
- Construction materials *
- Hazardous and toxic waste, batteries, asbestos, paint, etc.*
- Bulbs and fluorescent bulbs
- Electrical and electronic waste
- Scrap metal
- Oil
- Clothes
- Gardening waste

*Containers that are not accessible for businesses.

The Parc Verd, situated next to Ses Pesqueres football pitch, is open from Sunday to Monday, morning and evening, although the timetable may vary according to the service required.

Colònia de Sant Pere and the surrounding residential areas

In Colònia de Sant Pere, and the surrounding residential areas, the door-to-door collection service of different waste (paper, cardboard, other types of packaging, glass containers, other types of waste and organic waste) follows the same timetable as that of Artà.

Once a month junk and garden waste will be collected (no more than 4 bin bags of junk and 4 of garden waste) per household.

To arrange this service, you must call the Bassa d'en Fasol Municipal office (971 589 297).

La Colònia de Sant Pere Receycling Park (Parc Verd)

If you live in Colònia de Sant Pere, or the surrounding residential area, you can deposit household waste (paper, cardboard, other types of packaging, glass containers, other types of waste and organic waste) at the Parc Verd. This service operates from Sunday to Monday, morning and evening, although the timetable may vary according to the service requirements.



Tax on waste Those who recycle save money!

Households, businesses and companies who correctly separate their waste, can get an important reduction on tax paid.

Just sign up for the technical waste inspection service (ITR) and those who demonstrate correct separation of waste will be given a tax reduction. The reductions can be up to an additional 40% (according to the location and the type of building or housing.)

To sign up for the ITR system and enjoy the benefits, you must fill in a specific application form found at the Town Council.

Cardboard boxes

Do not throw away:

Paper napkins/Serviettes
Oil or painted-stained paper
Carton



Organic Materials

Fruit and vegetable waste
Meat and fish waste
Cake and bread waste
Cooked or inedible waste
Egg shells, nuts and seafood
Coffee granules and tea bags
Kitchen paper
Paper serviettes
Small garden waste
Wooden toothpicks

Do not throw away:

Stock, milk and other liquids
Ash
Nappies and excrements
Medication (you must take them to the pharmacy)
Oil (you must take them to the Parc Verd)

How to separate the waste?



Light Packaging:

Plastic containers
Cartons
Polystyrene trays
Drink can or food tins
Aluminium lids and small containers
Non-toxic empty spray cans and aerosols
Foil and cling film
Small wooden containers
Cork stoppers and plastic bottle tops

Do not throw away:

Toys and buckets/mop buckets
Hose pipes
Furniture and plastic hangers
CDs, DVDs and mobile cases



Glass containers:

Glass bottles
Glass jars

Do not throw away:

Flat glass and mirrors
Blubs and fluorescent bulbs



Waste:

Brushed up waste and vacuum cleaner bags
Cigarette ash and butts
Nappies and sanitary towels
Animal droppings
Oil or paint-stained paper
Chewing-gum
Razor blades
Ceramics
Baby wipes
Mixed or questionable waste

Do not throw away:

Recyclable waste
Bulky waste
Toxic or dangerous waste
